Please come to the front office to sign in.

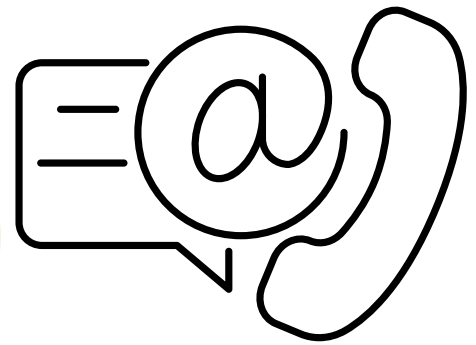
