

Is my child eligible?

If you are in receipt of the Universal Credit, you will be able to apply for 'Free School Meals' which then automatically registers your child as 'Pupil Premium'

All children in Reception and Year1/2 are entitled to a 'free' school lunch funded by the Government. **This is different to Free School Meals and you must apply for FSM to receive the PP benefits listed.**

Children in receipt of FSM do not need to take the 'free' lunch if they would prefer to bring their own packed lunch.

Is my child eligible?

Or, if your children are 'looked after', adopted from care, living with you in special guardianship or have ever been in care, please come and talk to a member of staff in the office. We will need to see legal documentation and then we can update our systems to give you access to PP Funding.

Or, if you are a member of the Armed Forces, please contact the office.

If your child has funded hours at our Nursery, they may be eligible for Early Years PP when they are aged 3. Please contact Sarah in Nursery or the school office for further information

Please note: If your circumstances change, and you no longer receive FSM, your child will still have Pupil Premium status and be eligible for some of the savings listed. If you have received FSM in the past, please contact the office as you may still be eligible for PP.

More details

School Uniform : A £15 voucher for the current school uniform supplier (at present, Karl Sports) is issued 4 times during a child's school life—at the beginning of Reception, Year 1, Year 3 and Year 5.

Breakfast Club : For children in receipt of FSM, Breakfast Club will be free.

Music Lessons: 50% off school music lessons up to a maximum of £100 during the child's school life

School Trips: 50% off all school trips (including Nursery trips) over the value of £5

Residential: 50% off **one** residential per key stage phase.

Free School Meals: Children in receipt of FSM can have a 'free' school lunch (currently £2.20/day)

School Clubs: 50% off all chargeable after school clubs up to a maximum of £100 during the child's school life

Nursery Lunchtime: Children in Nursery can stay for the lunchtime hour for free. They will still need to provide a packed lunch.

Please note, if the Government funding of 'Pupil Premium' changes, the school reserves the right to change its offer. Provision is directly related to the current funding arrangements.

How is this funded?

The Government award 'Pupil Premium' funding to all eligible children.

In the academic year 2014/2015, this funding was £1300 per pupil per year.

For children in Nursery, PP funding is 53p per funded hour (approx £300/yr)

Some of this money will be spent by the school on funding the initiatives mentioned overleaf for PP children.

Other money will be spent of supporting **ALL** children through the provision of additional support staff, paying for visitors to enhance the curriculum and staff training etc.

Full details of how the school spent last year's PP Funding is on the school website, or can be requested from the school office.
