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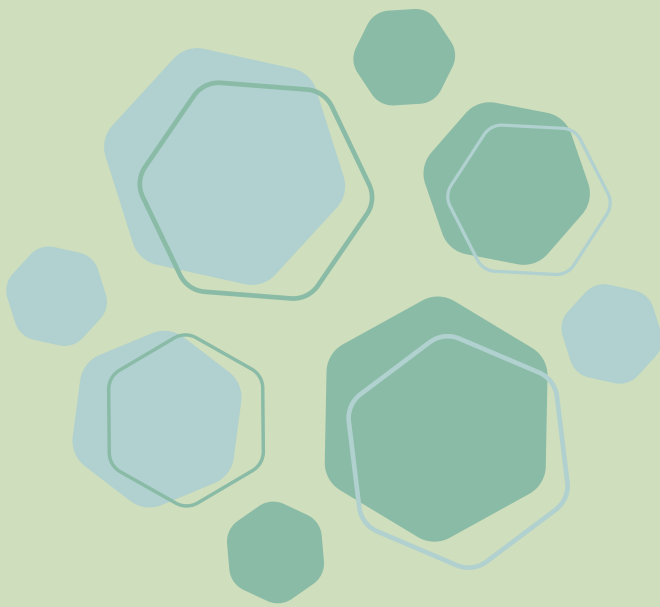

The Process

- 1 Assessment
- 2 Multi-Disciplinary Team Meeting
- 3 Sharing the Outcome



Assessment

Exploring your child's development and current behaviours.

Interview with a parent/caregiver to explore development and behaviours from birth to present day

An observational assessment with your child known as the ADOS-2

Liaison with your child's school

Questionnaires to explore possible co-existing conditions

A review of any relevant prior professional reports



Multi-Disciplinary Team Meeting

Once the assessment has been completed, the multidisciplinary team of professionals will meet to review the information gathered. They will confirm the outcome of the assessment in accordance with the diagnostic criteria for an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), in line with the DSM-5.
