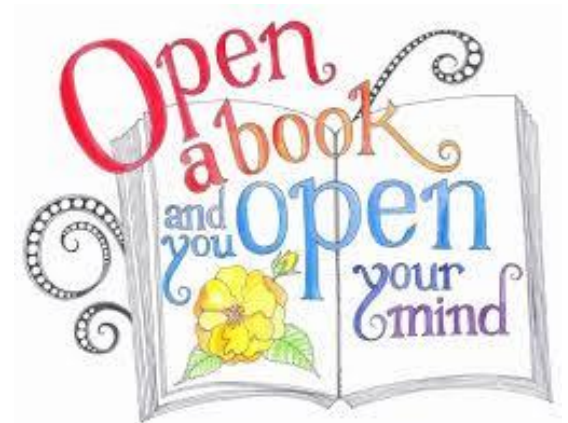
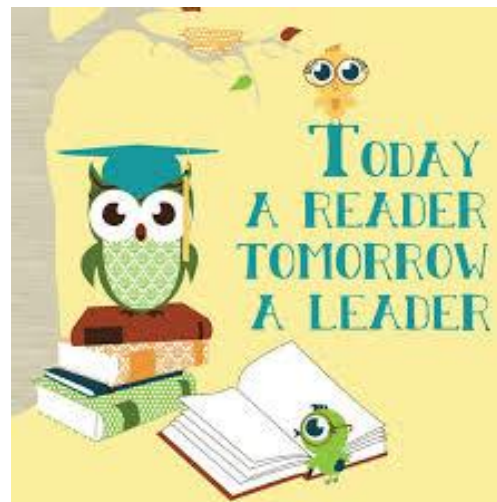

The key stage 2 tests are timetabled from Monday 8 May to Thursday 11 May 2023.

Uniform.


- Please make sure your children are wearing the appropriate uniform at all times, this includes a tie, (unless wearing PE kit or a summer dress for girls).
- If there is a reason why a child may not be wearing the correct school uniform, please let your class teacher know.
- Wearing the correct school uniform is an important part of belonging to a school community and sets the expectations for strict secondary school dress codes.

Attendance.

- Should be at least 97%
- Missing a key part of the teaching sequence leads to significant gaps in learning.
- Outside agencies will not consider assessing a child for specific learning difficulties until their attendance is in the high nineties.
- Interventions can not take place if a child is not in school, leading to children falling significantly behind their peers.



If your child lives in North Northamptonshire, from 1 September 2022, you can make an application for a:

- secondary school place for September 2023 if your child has their 11th birthday between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023 (year 6 in a primary or junior school)
- upper school (year 9 or 10) or UTC place (year 10) in another county from September 2023

If your child is already at secondary school and wishes to move, you will need to make an [in-year application](#) instead.

The closing date for applications will be 31 October

Open Evenings

- Check on your desired secondary school's website for dates of open evenings.
- KBA Open Evening- Thursday 29th Sept 5:45pm
- KSA Open Evening- Tuesday 11th October 6pm
- None-feeder primary schools, (such as St Andrew's) have very little to do with the application process and can not apply on a child's behalf, it is very much the parent/carer's responsibility to apply.

Applying late.

- Applying late means you will find out later than everyone else where your child is going.
- Your first choice may well be full and no longer taking in students.
- Could lead to your secondary school being located far from where you live.
- Having a sibling at a school is no longer a guarantee of a place.
- There is an appeals process if you do not agree with your allocation.

Online Safety

- Every year we are getting more and more children and parents coming to us with serious incidents that have happened online away from school.
- All of the problems have occurred on platforms which have a minimum age limit above Primary School.
- We will soon have a document to help parents deal with any serious incidents that may happen online at home.
