The St Andrew's School Day

(pre-coronavirus – subject to change come September 2020)

Your child should arrive at school between 8.30am and 8.45am; registration is at 8.45am. School finishes at 3.15pm (parents can pick up children in reception from 3pm to 3.15pm). Lunch times are staggered between 11.45am and 1.15pm – with all children getting one hour for lunch break.

In the morning, all children in Years 1-6 should be dropped off in the playground through the main gate between 8.30am and 8.45am. Staff from school will be on duty at this time but parents are welcome to stay with their child. A bell will ring at 8.45am; that will be a signal for all children to go into class on their own. Any children arriving after this will need to enter school via the school office and an adult will be required to sign them in.

Children in Reception should enter the same way as all our children but then walk up the slope along the right hand side of the building. The classroom will open at 8.45am. If you have children in any other year groups, please drop them off and pick them up from the main playground first.

Attendance at school is vital to a child's education. In accordance with school policies and national guidelines, we have to report absences and late arrivals to the appropriate authorities. Therefore, please ensure your child arrives at school on time each day and please inform the school office as early as possible about an absence due to illness. Holidays during term time are not allowed and cannot be authorised and will result in families being fined. We would encourage you to discuss any potential term time absences with the headteacher (Mr Arnell) before confirming a booking.
