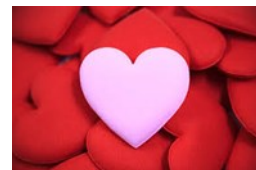

## Literacy

We will be continuing with Talk for writing in Year 3 and 4.

The children will write a journey tale and an article . We will be focusing on developing children's understanding of vocabulary and skills which include retrieving information, making predictions and reading around a word.

**Handwriting**—All children will be learning how to join their letters, writing fluently and holding the pencil.

### Purpose for Writing:

**Grammar:** Each teacher will be reactive to the children's needs, using the data from assessments. However, these units lend themselves to the teaching of different sentence types, descriptive writing and using a range of punctuation.

**Word Reading / Comprehension:** Children will learn to sequence and summarise a text, comment on an author's choice of language and use retrieval skills and explain and discuss their understanding of books, poems and other material.

### Spelling

## Spanish

We will be learning all about the phonic sounds in Spanish and how this differs from English.

## RE

We will be focusing on Christianity and discussing What Christians can learn from the creation story. We will be using drama to retell the story and perform this to the class.

## PSHE & Relationships education

Focus: My and my relationships.

Build on relationship and friendship skills; knowing how to work with others and use co-operation skills.

Our children will focus on how to show the value of LOVE and how we Live Our Values Everyday.

## Computing

This half term our children will be learning to stay safe on the internet. They will learn what risks there are, how to spot them and what to do if they feel threatened or compromised while online.

### Place Value

Year 3 - recognize 3 digit numbers. Year 4—recognizing a 4 digit number.

### Addition and Subtraction

Year 3—working with numbers up to 1000. Year 4—working with numbers up to 9999.

### Multiplication and division.

Year 3 - To know the times tables 2,5,10, 3. Year 4 - To know the times tables 6, 7 and 9.

## Science—

This term we will be looking at “Living Things” and categorising a range of animals using different methods. We will be learning all about how humans impact our planet and how to make positive changes.

## Geography

We will be focusing on a UK study. Looking at countries, regions and cities. The main focus will be learning locational knowledge and map reading skills.

## Art

We will be learning all about Stephen Wiltshire, a neuro-diverse artist who draws cityscapes.
