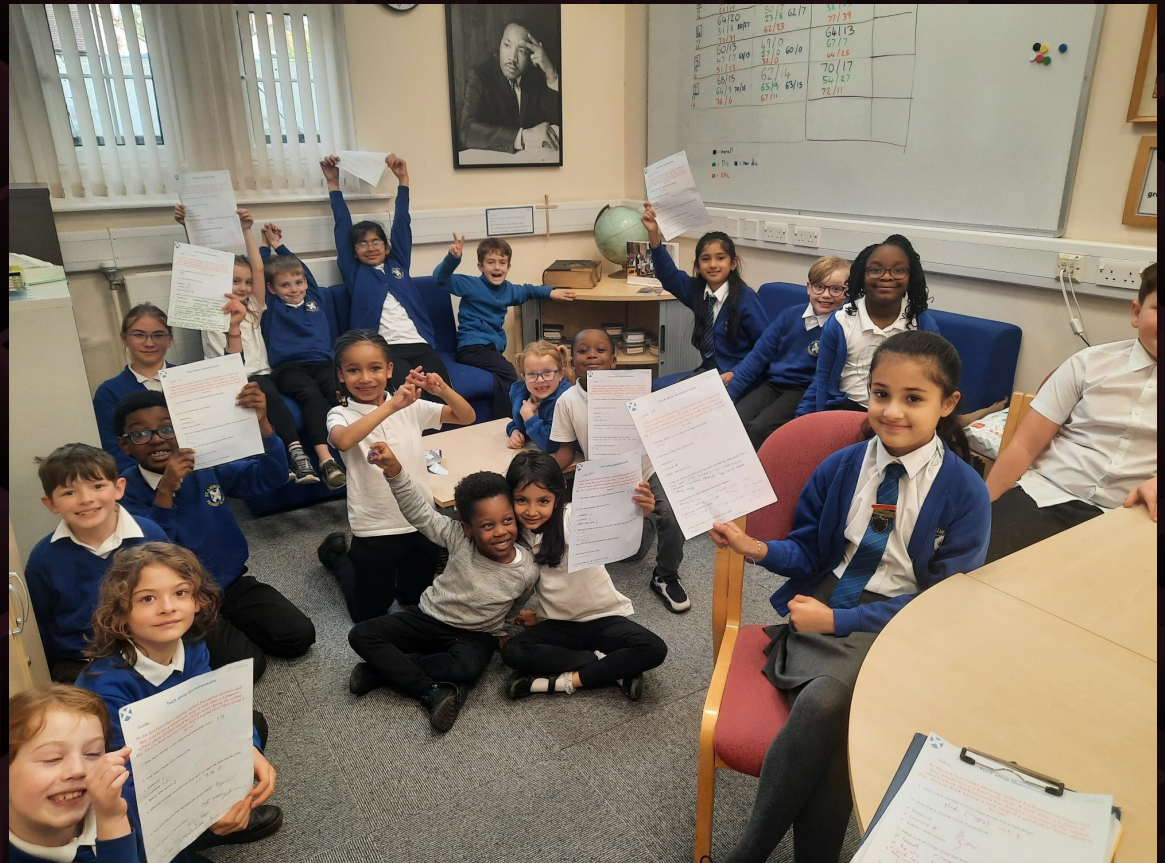


School Parliament's presentation to Governors on a TUCK SHOP.
