Day of the week.	Learning Suggestions
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Collect sets of objects from around the house – compare the two groups. What do you notice? Key Vocabulary – more/fewer• Follow White Rose Maths – Early years All About Me Week 2 – see link below!• https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/week-2/
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will be learning phonemes g o c k. Look out for the video on Tapestry to support this.• Find the Geraldine the Giraffe videos online for the phonemes above.• Find objects in the house beginning with the phonemes above.• Write the phonemes we have covered so far on paper, cut them out and start to push (blend) sounds together to make words – e.g. in am at sad
T4W	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ask the children to retell the Mr Wiggle and Mr Waggle story using the story map and story on Tapestry.• Join in with the video posted on Tapestry!• Can the children start to draw the story map for themselves? Maybe start with just the beginning of the story.
Fine Motor	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If you have child friendly scissors at home encourage your child to cut around basic shapes.• Draw and colour in pictures – start with basic shapes to make houses/people/animals.• Use playdough to roll/press/pinch using fingers.
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share as many story books as you can with your child.• Post on Tapestry a story that you are reading - ask questions such as – Why do you like this story? What happens at the beginning/end? Which is your favourite picture?
