Day of the week.	Learning Suggestions
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we are looking at numbers 1 2 and 3 and starting to make comparisons between the numbers. We are talking about more/less one more than/one less than. Search for number songs on the internet that count on and back. Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learning new phonemes j v w x - google Geraldine the Giraffe videos and find objects around the house that begin with the letters Sing the tricky word song from link below on You Tube - copy and paste the link into the You Tube search. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0 Please go over the videos Mrs Smith has posted on Tapestry!
T4W	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This term we are focussing on the Gruffalo story. If you have the story at home please read it. If not you can find the story on You Tube or Cebeebies. Draw your favourite character and talk about why you like the character.
Fine Motor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find some games or activities that use fine motor skills. Some examples include jigsaws/beads/pegs in boards/using clothes pegs to attach to different objects – anything really that involves getting those hands and fingers working. Have a go at some of the jumper family letters. h n m n – down bump, back up, push over, down bump flick! Mrs Smith's video is on Tapestry https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=BTlztuOLdKg Draw a fox from the Gruffalo story. Use the You Tube video to help you.
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share as many story books as you can with your child. Post on Tapestry a story that you are reading - ask questions such as – Why do you like this story? What happens at the beginning/end? Which is your favourite picture?
