Day of the week.	Learning Suggestions

Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Learning new phonemes h b f l - google Geraldine the Giraffe videos and find objects around the house that begin with the letters</li><li>• Sing the tricky word song from link below on You Tube - copy and paste the link into the You Tube search.</li><li>• <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0</a></li><li>• Please go over the videos Mrs Smith has posted on Tapestry!</li></ul>
T4W	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ask the children to retell the The Little Red Hen story using the story map and story on Tapestry.</li><li>• Join in with the video posted on Tapestry!</li><li>• Can the children start to draw the story map for themselves? Maybe start with just the beginning of the story.</li></ul>
Fine Motor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If you have child friendly scissors at home encourage your child to cut around basic shapes.</li><li>• Draw and colour in pictures – start with basic shapes to make houses/people/animals.</li><li>• Use playdough to roll/press/pinch using fingers.</li><li>• Have a go at some of the jumper family letters. h n m n – down bump, back up, push over, down bump flick! Mrs Smith’s video is on Tapestry</li></ul>
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Share as many story books as you can with your child.</li><li>• Post on Tapestry a story that you are reading - ask questions such as – Why do you like this story? What happens at the beginning/end? Which is your favourite picture?</li></ul>
