Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we are looking at numbers 1 2 and 3 Watch the videos from the link below and have a go at activities 4 and 5 https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/its-me-1-2-3-week-1/
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learning new phonemes h b f l - google Geraldine the Giraffe videos and find objects around the house that begin with the letters Sing the tricky word song from link below on You Tube - copy and paste the link into the You Tube search. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0 Please go over the videos Mrs Smith has posted on Tapestry!
T4W	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask the children to retell the The Little Red Hen story using the story map and story on Tapestry. Join in with the video posted on Tapestry! Can the children start to draw the story map for themselves? Maybe start with just the beginning of the story.
Fine Motor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have child friendly scissors at home encourage your child to cut around basic shapes. Draw and colour in pictures – start with basic shapes to make houses/people/animals. Use playdough to roll/press/pinch using fingers. Have a go at some of the jumper family letters. h n m n – down bump, back up, push over, down bump flick! Mrs Smith's video is on Tapestry
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share as many story books as you can with your child. Post on Tapestry a story that you are reading - ask questions such as – Why do you like this story? What happens at the beginning/end? Which is your favourite picture?
